

Two Scholarships Available for Area Technical Communication Students

The STC Lone Star Community offers scholarships for the 2006 2007 academic year

Dallas, Texas—October 16, 2006 — The Society for Technical Communication (STC) Lone Star Community's Scholarship Committee is accepting scholarship applications for the 2006 through Spring 2007 academic year. These scholarship programs assist all students who are undertaking a technical communication degree or certificate and intend to pursue a career in the wide field of technical communications. The Scholarship Committee evaluates applicants' academic records and potential for contributing to the technical communication profession. However, when applicants are judged comparable in these respects, the committee also considers a student's financial need.

The Lone Star Community invites everyone who meets the following eligibility requirements to submit an application, as defined at http://www.stc-dfw.org/pages/schol_main.htm

Eligibility Requirements

- Graduate or undergraduate student working toward a degree or certificate in the technical communication field;
- Living or attending school in STC Region 5 (Arizona, Arkansas, Louisiana, New Mexico, Oklahoma, Texas, and Utah).

To be considered for this first round of scholarship awards, LSC must receive submissions no later than October 20, 2006.

Judging will take place in November. Winners will be notified by phone or mail. Checks will be disbursed in November. The scholarship recipients will be formally recognized at the Lone Star Community's December meeting.
